

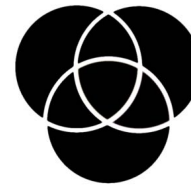
WORSHIP SPOTLIGHT

Why do we have a “Call to Worship”?

It was God who spoke the world into existence. It was God who breathed life into Adam. And after Adam condemned all humanity by his sin, it was God who spoke of the coming Redeemer. God later called his people out of Egypt to worship Him. Through the Prophets God called Israel to repent and turn from their idols. It was God, through his Angelic messengers, who heralded the coming of Jesus. And Jesus called disciples to come and follow him. God is the one who calls to us. He always initiates our relationship with Him.

Therefore it is appropriate that God have the first word in our worship service, that His voice be the first voice heard. The pastor, who is ordained to speak God’s Word as his representative, reads a portion of Scripture. This is usually taken from the Psalms or some other passage that specifically calls God’s people to worship Him.

We should hear the Call to Worship as God himself calling us into His presence, where He intends to work new creation in us through Jesus Christ.
