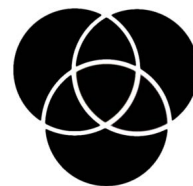
What are the 12 Days of Christmas?

The season of Christmas extends from Christmas Day to the Feast of the Epiphany, which always falls on January 6th.

Thus there are 12 days from December 25th to January 6th during which we celebrate the birth of Jesus. This season is known as Christmastide. Sundays that fall within this 12 day period are named First/Second Sunday after Christmas.

While the royal color purple is used during the Sundays in Advent, the color white is used during the Christmas season. White reminds us the Light of the World has come to us in Jesus.

John 8:12 - Again Jesus spoke to them, saying, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will not walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."
